
KNOW THE FACTS!

Access to safe, affordable homes builds a strong foundation for families and communities. But too many Minnesotans lack good housing options. Be informed. Know the facts. On any given day, 51% of people experiencing homelessness in MN are youth.

Across Minnesota, there is a shortage of rental homes affordable and available to extremely low-income households, whose incomes are at or below the poverty guideline or 30% of their area median income.

While a significant portion of the rental and owner-occupied housing is aging (built before 1970), new construction is not keeping up with demand. Of particular concern is the gap between the number of available units for extremely low income households - and the number of people who need them.
